Our History

In the late 1970's the local community of Stoke Heath saw some young people in their community struggling and getting into trouble. A group of volunteers came together and came up with the idea that with access to emergency housing in their local community, these young people could be supported to make a change. They approached the local council for help and were given a property, 84 Valley Road – and Valley House was born.

Valley House Today

Since its beginning in 1977 Valley House has grown from 1 house to an organisation offering a range of accommodation and community based services for vulnerable people in and around Coventry. We currently employ over 70 staff and have an annual turnover of £2.1m.

Our Services

We offer a range of services aimed at individuals and families in and around Coventry.

Specialist Accommodation

We provide specialist accommodation for young parents, and individuals and families who are experiencing domestic violence.



Community Support

If you are a young parent living with your family but want your own home, or if you already have a tenancy but are struggling to hold it down, we can help. We can also help you manage debts, claim benefits, get emotional support learn about parenting and much more.

Youth

We work with individuals from 13 to 25 years old. Our services help young people overcome challenges in their life, develop new skills, and plan for the future.

Community Wellbeing

Our confidential service is available to anyone aged 16 years old and over. We offer both practical and emotional support to help deal with immediate problems as well as underlying issues that may be affecting someone's health and wellbeing.

Nursery

Our nursery is for children aged 6 weeks to 5 years old. Our qualified staff are passionate about providing the best opportunities for children to learn, play and have fun!
