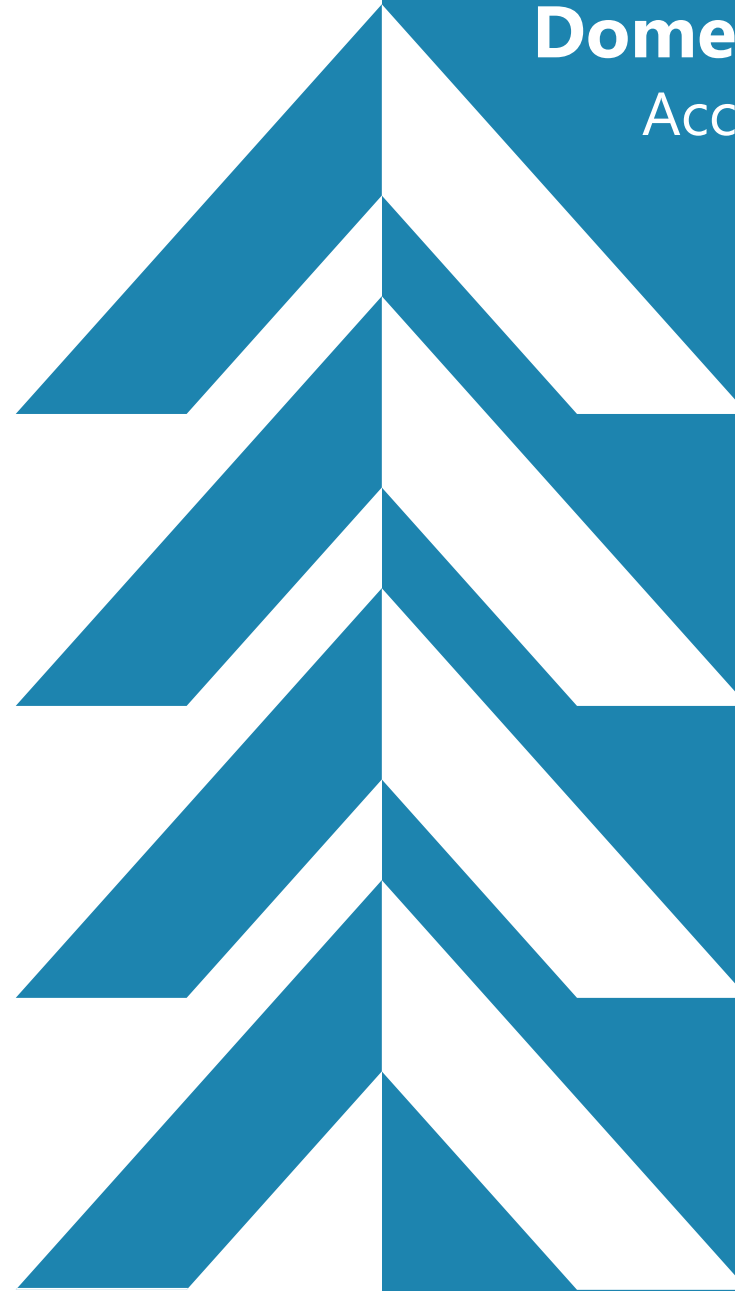

Domestic Abuse

Accommodation Service

Valley House provides supported accommodation for female and male Victims of domestic abuse aged from 16 years, it also includes their families (children and young people).

Referrals into the service will be taken 24 hrs a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.

Referrals can be taken from professionals and self-referrals either by phone or by attending our office.

What's Included?

- A range of self-contained, family and shared accommodation
- Separate women only and male accommodation
- Accommodation for families with older male children
- Accommodation adapted for disability and carers
- Specialist support for BAMER, LGBT, older people and people with care and support needs and other underrepresented groups

Support we offer

- Risk assessment and safety planning
- Culturally specific support
- Practical and emotional support
- 1 to1 case work and structured group work
- Court support for service users involved in criminal justice and civil proceedings
- Family support work for families accessing our accommodation
- Signposting and advocacy

Valley House also offer:

- Peer support groups
- Coffee mornings
- Counselling Service
- Service user involvement and volunteering opportunities
- Low level follow-on (aftercare) support to reduce isolation, increase confidence and skills.
- Onsite Nursery
- Young Parents Support
- Youth Group
- Social activities
- Learning and Development opportunities

Womens Refuge

Valley House also offers a women's only refuge for women and children fleeing from domestic abuse aged between 18 - 25. This is a 13 bed accommodation consisting of 2 shared properties.

The refuge provides a place where women and children can engage with each other and support each other through their current situation. It can be difficult for someone fleeing domestic abuse to be alone. Our refuge provides a safe space where you are able to build on your social networks which may have been taken away from you during an abusive relationship and build on your confidence.


With staff being on site we are able to build a better relationship with our service users engaging closely with them and developing new ideas such as group activities.

What's Included?

- Shared accommodation with large family rooms for women & children only
- Ground floor accommodation available for someone with a disability
- Specialist support for BAMER, LGBT, younger people
